GOAT | WEEK THREE

BOTTOM LINE | We live like Jesus did when we make personal time with God a priority.

SERIES DESCRIPTION | Whether or not you're a Christian, it's hard to argue that any man has had a greater influence on history than Jesus. Two thousand years after Jesus' time on earth, we still talk about Him and what He did. In this series, we take a look at the personal habits that made Jesus the GOAT.

GOAL OF LARGE GROUP |

For students to see that, even though Jesus was the GOAT, He still prioritized time with God. If Jesus needed to have time with God, we definitely do.

SCRIPTURE |

John 13:15

Mark 1:35

TRUTH |

Jesus is the Son of God. The Bible even calls Him the Image of the Invisible God (Colossians 1:15). Because He was a picture of God, He had access to everything that God has access to (he knew everything, was all powerful, etc), but He STILL saw time with God as important.

Jesus knew that everything will fall in place if He prioritized His relationship with God.

APPLICATION |

Everyone wants to be the GOAT - We have so many plans and dreams for our lives, BUT none of these things will be worthwhile if we leave our relationship with God in the dust as we pursue these plans and dreams. Since Jesus prioritized His relationship with God, so should we.
